Focus: **Specialty/Wildlife Rehabilitation** – This field trip will focus on work done at the Wildlife Rehabilitation Clinic

Field Trip Description: Join us for an exclusive behind-the-scenes tour of the Wildlife Rehabilitation Clinic. Each year more than 2,500 animals are treated at the clinic and nearly 50 percent are released back into the wild. Learn about causes of injuries, treatment protocols and what you can do to help injured and orphaned wildlife. This is a fascinating program and space is extremely limited.
