Maximum Group Size: 20

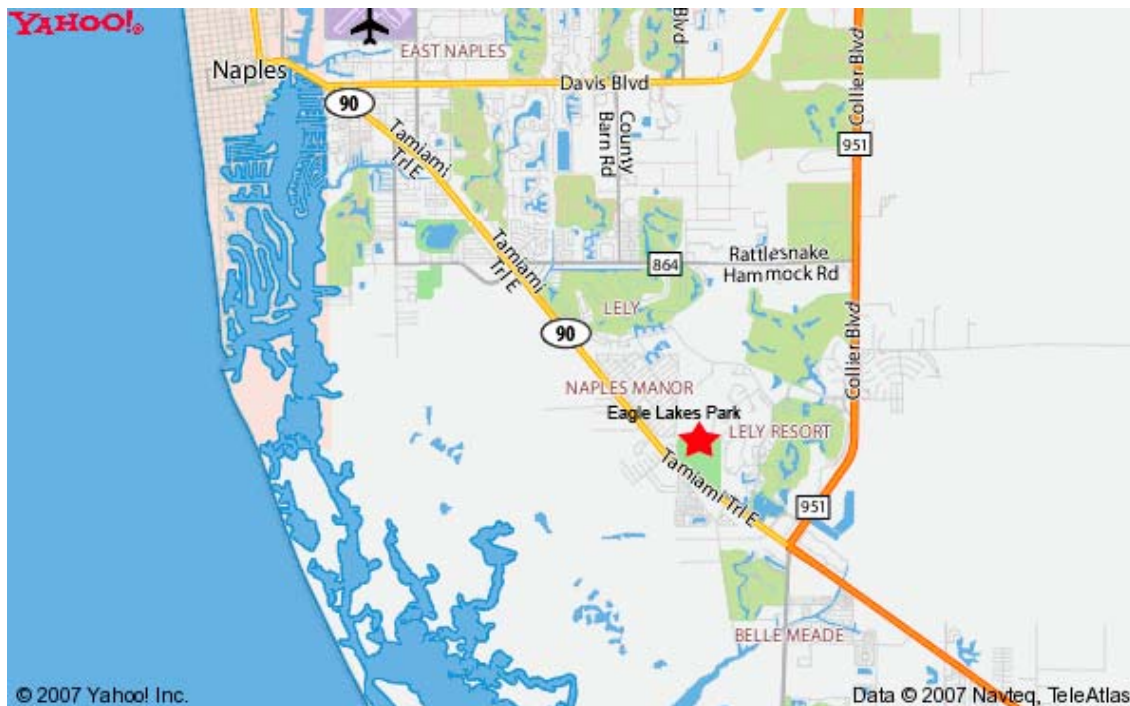
Time Begin: 3:00 pm
