

Native American Occupation Time Periods in SW Florida (estimated, based on various researchers)

Paleoindian: 14,500 - 11,500 BP
(before present)

ARCHAIC, 11,500 – 2,500 BP

- Early Archaic, 11,500 – 8,000 BP
- Middle Archaic, 8,000 – 5,000 BP
- Late Archaic, 5,000 – 2,500 BP

Caloosahatchee Periods

(refers to area from Caloosahatchee River up to Charlotte Harbor):

Caloosahatchee V	AD 1500 – 1725
Caloosahatchee IV	AD 1400 – 1500
Caloosahatchee III	AD 1200 – 1400
Caloosahatchee IIB	AD 800 – 1200
Caloosahatchee IIA	AD 500 – 800
Caloosahatchee I	500 BC – AD 500
